**18. Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie** | Bottega, Veneto, Italy  
Bottega's Pinot Grigio is a deliciously dry, fresh and inviting white wine with fruity hints. Great with salads and light pasta dishes.

**19. Chateau de la Saule Montagny** | 1er Cru, Burgundy, France

### 1. House White | Valviejo Viura | Bodegas Los Tinos, Spain

A white that stands out for its aromas of fruit and white flowers. Humid Mediterranean winds and a continental climate result in the leisurely, gradual ripening leading to wines of outstanding personality and freshness like this Viura.
